## NAEP Mathematics 2019, Grade 4, All Students <br> Idaho and Her Northwest Neighbors

The mathematics assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed-response questions to examine student skills in number properties and operations, measurement, geometry, algebra and functions, and data analysis and probability. Mathematics scores range from 0 to 500, where 214 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 249 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 282 is Advanced ( $\mathrm{A}+$ ).


## NAEP 2019 Mathematics

$\checkmark$ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 mathematics average score that was higher than their peers in two (2) neighbor states: Nevada and Oregon.
$\checkmark$ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 mathematics average score that was not significantly different from their peers in four (4) neighbor states: Montana, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.
$\checkmark$ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 mathematics average score that was lower than their peers in none (0) of their neighbor states.
