


Idaho vs. National Student Demographic Groups NAEP 2019 Reading, Grade 8

The eighth-grade reading assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed response questions to examine student skills to examine student knowledge and skills using grade-appropriate literary and informational texts. Scores range from zero (0) to 500, where 243 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 281 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 323 is Advanced (A+).



Idaho vs. National Public Demographic Groups NAEP 2019 Reading, Grade 8

NAEP 2019 Reading Assessment, Grade 8:

Four (4) eighth-grade student group in Idaho had an average score on the NAEP 2019 reading test that was *higher than* its national peer group: all students, male students, female students, and students who qualified for free or reduced prices lunches.

Four (4) eighth-grade student groups in Idaho had an average score on the NAEP 2019 reading test that was *not significantly different* from their national peers: White students, Hispanic students, students not eligible for free or reduced priced lunches, and students with limited English proficiency.

One (1) eighth-grade student group in Idaho had an average score on the NAEP 2019 reading test that was *lower than* its national peer groups: students with disabilities who have an IEP.
