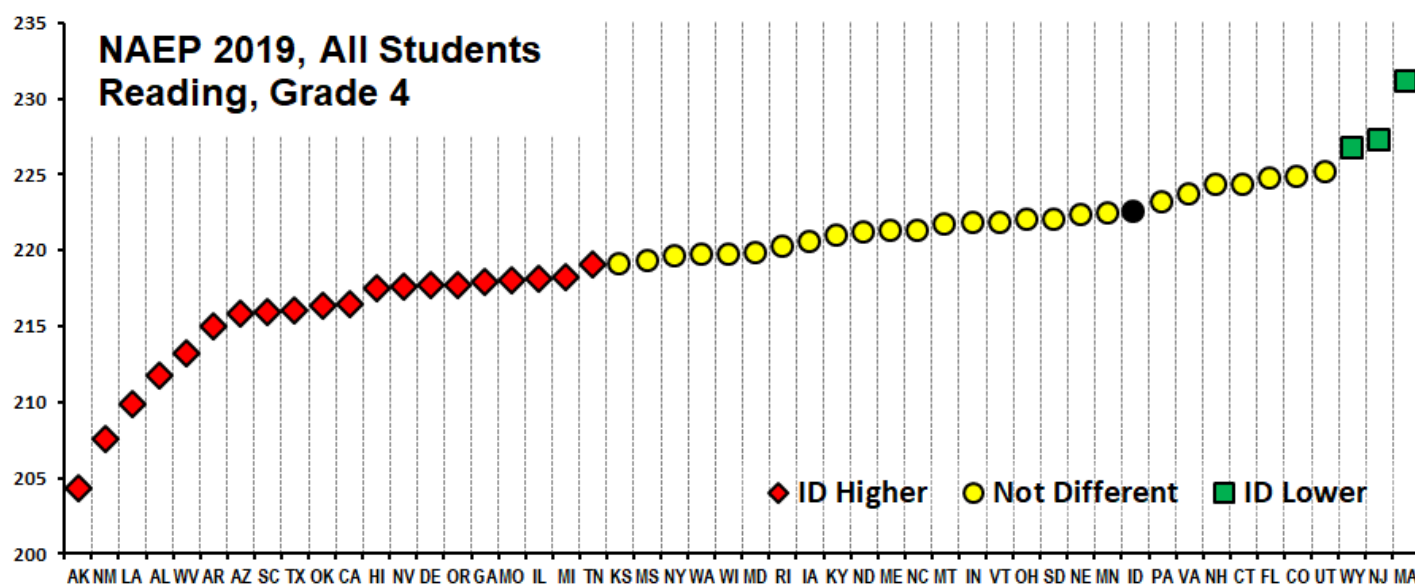




NAEP Reading 2019 Across State Comparisons Idaho, Grade 4, All Students

The fourth-grade reading assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed response questions to examine student skills to examine student knowledge and skills using grade-appropriate literary and informational texts. Scores range from zero (0) to 500, where 208 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 238 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 268 is Advanced (A+).



NAEP 2019 Reading

- ✓ Idaho’s fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *higher than* their peers in twenty (20) states: AK, AL, AR, AZ, CA, DE, GA, HI, IL, LA, MI, MO, NM, NV, OK, OR, SC, TN, TX, and WV.
- ✓ Idaho’s fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *not significantly different from* their peers in twenty-six (26) states: CO, CT, FL, IA, IN, KS, KY, MD, ME, MN, MS, MT, NC, ND, NE, NH, NY, OH, PA, RI, SD, UT, VA, VT, WA, and WI,
- ✓ Idaho’s fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *lower than* their peers in three (3) states: MA, NJ, and WY.
- ✓ Idaho’s fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *higher than* their peers in public schools across the nation.
