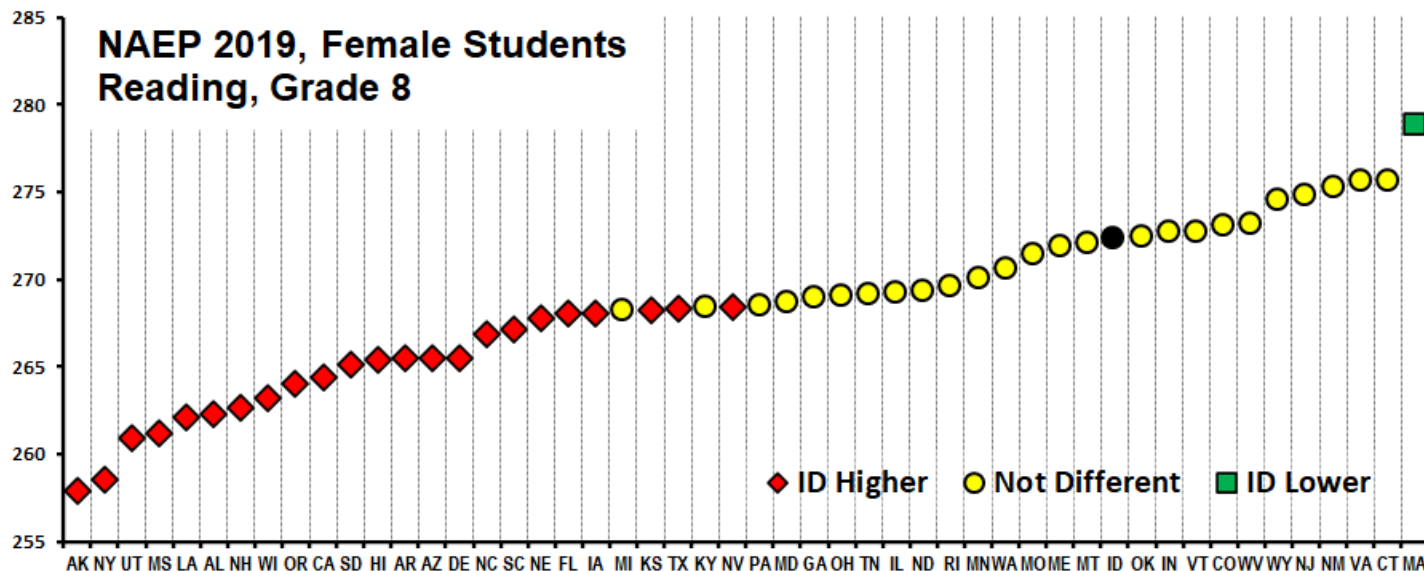




NAEP Reading 2019 Across State Comparisons Idaho, Grade 8, Female Students

The eighth-grade reading assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed response questions to examine student skills to examine student knowledge and skills using grade-appropriate literary and informational texts. Scores range from zero (0) to 500, where 243 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 281 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 323 is Advanced (A+).



NAEP 2019 Reading

- ✓ Idaho’s Female eighth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *higher than* their peers in twenty-three (23) states: AK, AL, AR, AZ, CA, DE, FL, HI, IA, KS, LA, MS, NC, NE, NH, NV, NY, OR, SC, SD, TX, UT, and WI.
- ✓ Idaho’s Female eighth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *not significantly different* from their peers in twenty-five (25) states: CO, CT, GA, IL, IN, KY, MD, ME, MI, MN, MO, MT, ND, NJ, NM, OH, OK, PA, RI, TN, VA, VT, WA, WV, and WY.
- ✓ Idaho’s Female eighth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *lower than* their peers in one (1) state: MA
- ✓ Idaho’s Female eighth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *higher than* their peers in public schools across the nation.

Note: Comparisons based on statistical tests (.05 level) using unrounded numbers that considered the magnitude of difference and standard errors.
