


NAEP Reading 2019, Grade 4, All Students Idaho and Her Northwest Neighbors

The fourth-grade reading assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed response questions to examine student skills to examine student knowledge and skills using grade-appropriate literary and informational texts. Scores range from zero (0) to 500, where 208 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 238 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 268 is Advanced (A+).



NAEP 2019 Reading

- ✓ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *higher than* their peers in two (2) neighbor states: Nevada and Oregon.
- ✓ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *not significantly different from* their peers in three (3) neighbor states: Montana, Utah, and Washington.
- ✓ Idaho's fourth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *lower than* their peers in one (1) neighbor states: Wyoming.
