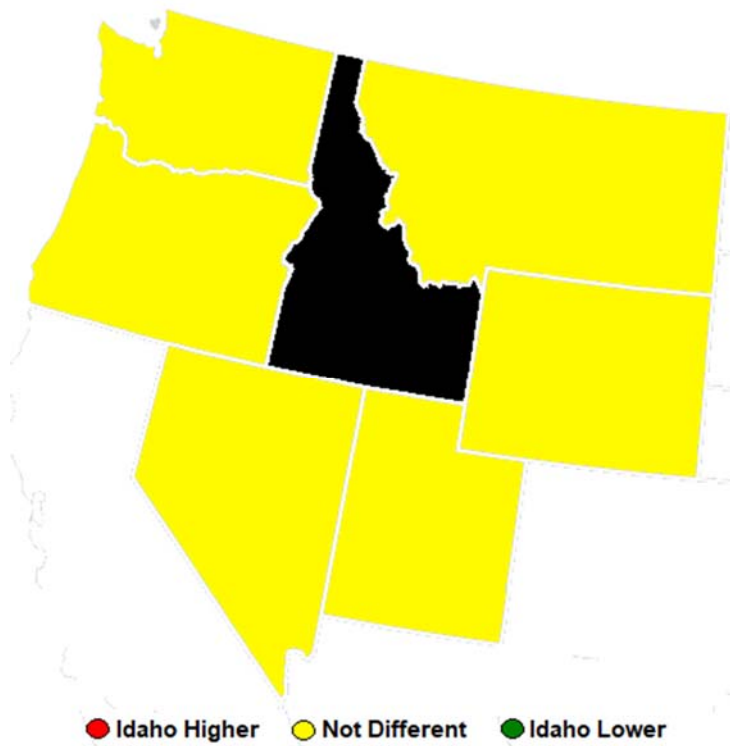




NAEP Reading 2019, Grade 8, All Students Idaho and Her Northwest Neighbors

The eighth-grade reading assessment of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) used multiple choice and constructed response questions to examine student skills to examine student knowledge and skills using grade-appropriate literary and informational texts. Scores range from zero (0) to 500, where 243 is Basic (C or B, meets grade-level expectations), 281 is Proficient (A, higher than grade level performance), and 323 is Advanced (A+).



- ✓ Idaho's eighth graders had a NAEP 2019 reading average score that was *not significantly different* from their peers in any of Idaho's six neighbor states: Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.

Note: Comparisons based on statistical tests (.05 level) using unrounded numbers that considered the magnitude of difference and standard errors.
