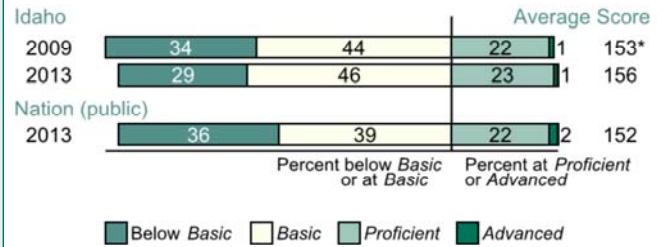


**Overall Results**

- In 2013, the average score of twelfth-grade students in Idaho was 156. This was higher than the average score of 152 for public school students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Idaho in 2013 (156) was higher than their average score in 2009 (153).
- The score gap between higher performing students in Idaho (those at the 75th percentile) and lower performing students (those at the 25th percentile) was 38 points in 2013. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (41 points).
- The percentage of students in Idaho who performed at or above the NAEP *Proficient* level was 24 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (23 percent).
- The percentage of students in Idaho who performed at or above the NAEP *Basic* level was 71 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (66 percent).

**Compare the Average Score in 2013 to Other States/Jurisdictions**

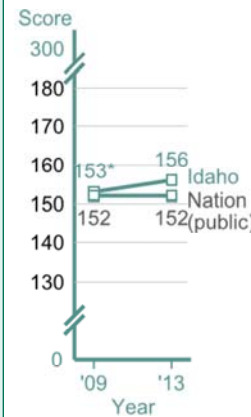

In 2013, the average score in **Idaho** (156) was

- lower than those in 5 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 4 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 3 states/jurisdictions

**Score Gaps for Student Groups**

- Data are not reported for Black students in 2013, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2013, Hispanic students had an average score that was 24 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (25 points).
- In 2013, male students in Idaho had an average score that was higher than female students by 5 points.
