# Idaho Charter School and Neighborhood School Performance on the Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT 2019) 

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Idaho high school juniors take the Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT), a college admissions test. This testing costs the state about a million dollars a year, but average composite mathematics and reading/writing scores are typically the only results reported to the public. Idaho's overall SAT performance slumped in mathematics and reading/writing from 2017 to 2019 for both charter and neighborhood schools.

Declines in Academic Status. From 2017 to 2019, the SAT mathematics average score dropped 11 points for Idaho charter schools and 13 points for Idaho neighborhood schools. The average SAT reading/writing average score dropped 18 points for charter schools and 7 points for neighborhood schools.

Declines in Academic Growth. From 2017 to 2019, the effect sizes in SAT mathematics were negative for Idaho charter schools ( -0.025 ) and Idaho neighborhood schools ( -0.039 ). The SAT effect sizes were negative for SAT reading/writing in charter schools $(-0.035)$ and in neighborhood schools (-0.016).

School Academic Status and Growth. While overall academic status and growth suffered statewide, it is important to note that some schools celebrated gains while others suffered losses. The percentages of charter and neighborhood schools that had academic status and academic growth gains and losses in mathematics and reading/writing are displayed in Figure 1. Note: no change in status or growth for a school (i.e., a zero gain) was counted as a gain (a school maintaining its previous achievement level ought to count for something).

Figure 1. The percentage of Idaho charter and neighborhood schools that had gains or losses in academic status (average score) or academic growth (effect size) on the SAT 2019 mathematics and reading/writing assessments.

Academic Status


K-12 Research Idaho employed SAT scale scores from 2017 and 2019 (expressed as Idaho percentile ranks) to compare the performance of Idaho's top performing charter and neighborhood schools in mathematics and reading/writing, in terms of status and growth. The Idaho percentile rank (PR) of 77, for example, meant that a school (or the composite of a group of schools) scored the "same as or higher than" 77 percent of the 189 Idaho schools for which the State Department of Education provided SAT scores for both 2017 and 2019.

Statis and Growth of Top Performing Schools. In 2019, the academic status of Idaho's 15 top performing charter schools and 15 top neighborhood schools were similar in mathematics and reading/writing. However, there were notable academic growth differences in both mathematics and reading/writing that favored neighborhood schools. The composite Idaho Percentile Ranks for academic status and academic growth of the top 15 charter schools and top 15 neighborhood schools for SAT 2019 are displayed in Figure 2. Narratives follow Figure 2.

## SAT 2019 Status - Idaho Percentile Ranks (PR) and Common Language Descriptors

* Idaho's SAT 2019 mathematics status was $\mathrm{PR}=94$ for the top 15 charter schools and $\mathrm{PR}=90$ for the top 15 neighborhood schools. The SAT 2019 mathematics status was "high" for both charter and neighborhood schools.
* Idaho's SAT 2019 reading/writing status was $\mathrm{PR}=86$ for the top 15 charter schools and $\mathrm{PR}=88$ for the top 15 neighborhood schools. The SAT 2019 reading/writing status was "above average" for both charter and neighborhood schools.


## SAT 2019 Growth - Idaho Percentile Ranks (PR) with Common Language Descriptors

* Idaho's SAT 2019 mathematics growth was $\mathrm{PR}=67$ for the top 15 charter schools and $\mathrm{PR}=96$ for the top 15 neighborhood schools. The SAT 2019 mathematics growth was "high average" for charter schools, and "very high" for neighborhood schools.
* Idaho's SAT 2019 reading/writing growth was $\mathrm{PR}=80$ for the top 15 charter schools and $\mathrm{PR}=95$ for the top 15 neighborhood schools. The SAT 2019 reading/writing growth was "above average" for charter schools, and "high" for neighborhood schools.

List of the "Top 15 " Schools. The names and Idaho percentile ranks for the top 15 charter schools and the top 15 neighborhood schools identified for each study group (mathematics academic status, reading/writing academic status, mathematics academic growth, and reading/writing academic growth) are listed in Appendix A (page 5).

List of Academic Status and Growth for all 189 Schools. Alpha-order list of all 189 schools for which the SDE provided 2017 and 2019 data, displaying Idaho percentile ranks (PR) and common language descriptors for school mathematics and reading/writing academic status from 2019 and school mathematics and reading/writing academic growth from 2017 to 2019. The alpha-list is in Appendix B (page 8).

## Methodology

The State Department of Education provided school-level SAT data from 189 Idaho schools with scores for both 2017 and 2019. This included 27 charter schools and 162 neighborhood schools, but important parts of this study focused only on the top 15 charter schools and the top 15 neighborhood schools.

Percentile Ranks. Percentile ranks (PR) for mathematics and reading/writing were calculated for all 189 schools, with a separate calculation for each of the four study groups. A percentile rank (PR) of 84, for example, identified a performance that was the same as or higher than 84 percent of the 189 schools. A PDF file displaying all school's percentile ranks in each of the four study groups is available in Appendix B.

The use of Idaho percentile ranks means makes it impossible for each school to score at or above the $50^{\text {th }}$ percentile rank. Percentile ranks for the 189 schools in this study will range from a high of 99 to a low of 1 .

Descriptors. Traditional "common language descriptors" were applied to describe PRs. Very high (96-99), high (89-95), above average (77-88), high average (60-76), average (41-59), low average (24-40), below average (12-23), low (5-11), and very low (1-4).

Top Performing Charter and Neighborhood Schools. The top 15 performing charter schools were selected for each of four study groups: mathematics status, reading/writing status,
mathematics growth, and reading/writing growth. In similar manner, the top 15 performing neighborhood schools were then picked to enable comparisons.

Academic Status. The school's average SAT score for 2019 was selected as the metric for academic status. Critics have noted, however, that reported SAT average scores are less descriptive of student achievement than of the socioeconomic status and educational values of the community that the school served. This seems to hold true whether students were enrolled for neighborhood schools by ZIP code or for charter schools through a recruiting procedure.

Academic Growth. The "effect size" statistic was selected as the metric for academic growth. Effect size estimates the practical significance (not the "statistical significance) of the difference between two average scores. Effect size was the difference between a school's average SAT scores from 2017 and 2019, divided by the pooled standard deviations from 2017 and 2019. The effect size represented the magnitude of achievement encouraged by the teaching-learning culture of a school.
